In the coming days you will see Virginia Natural Gas, or one of its trusted contractors, performing routine inspections in your neighborhood. Virginia Natural Gas, along with its contractor, Vector Force Development (Vector), will be inspecting underground facilities in your neighborhood.

Inspect Sewers

Sewer inspections are part of Virginia Natural Gas' safety practices. If your sewer service is not accessible from the street, Vector will make contact with you to coordinate a sewer line inspection from inside your property. There will be no interruption to your natural gas or sewer service during the inspection unless repairs are needed. Vital information from the inspection will be marked on lawns and sidewalks with spray paint.
