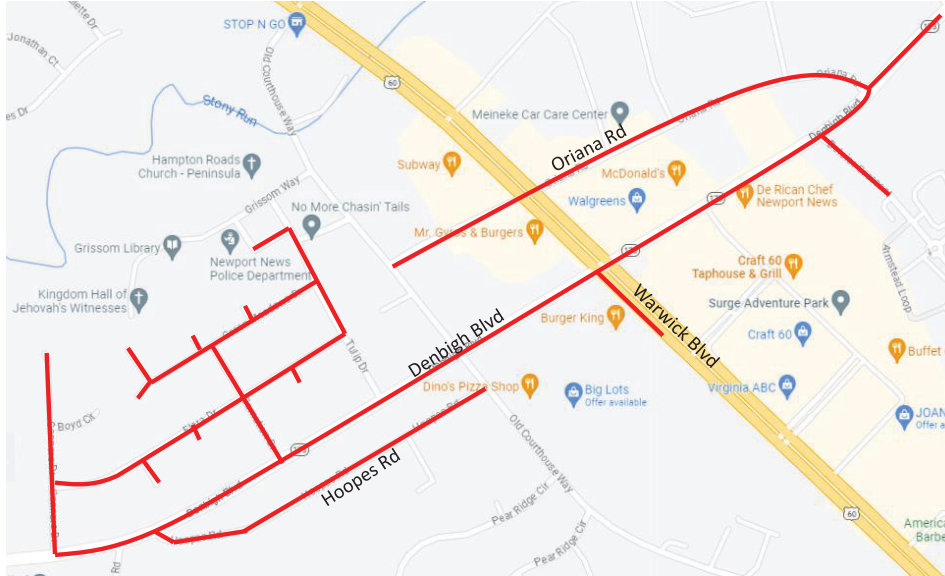


Hoopes SAVE
